





## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PUBLIC

**ARRIVE ON THE COURSE** in good time and park your car off the race track or in designated areas. Even off the course, be careful where you park. Remember that any road is a potential escape route for ambulances and tow trucks, so make sure they can pass. Avoid clogging up roads leading to the race course.

**NEVER OCCUPY AREAS PROHIBITED TO THE PUBLIC,** avoid climbing on plants or other risky places, you could fall and hurt yourself or others.

**NEVER CLOG** the road, remember that not all racing cars are noisy;

**DO NOT PUT YOURSELF** into dangerous situations. Do not lean out or position yourself on the road, instead look for a safe place;

**STRICTLY RESPECT** the instructions of the Marshals, the Organization staff and the Police;

**COLLABORATE** with the Marshals, the Organization staff and the Police to convince those who do not want to listen to their instructions. Do not hinder the work of recovering the car from the Stewards or the tow truck or the work of the paramedics, should they intervene.

KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE of at least 8 meters from the road, possibly on a hill or embankment;

**NEVER STOP** on the edge of the road, below road level or inside the hairpin bends or between two hairpin bends;

**ALWAYS AVOID** staying on the outside of the bends, on the shoulders of the bridges and on the edge of the road;

**NEVER MOVE** before ALL the cars have passed;

**DO NOT LEAVE** rubbish or leftovers lying around, but use the appropriate containers or take them away with you, to dispose of them conveniently at home;

**RESPECT THE NATURE THAT SURROUNDS YOU**, our race takes place in a wonderful environment and must be preserved as such. Do not throw anything on the road (gravel, earth, etc.), to increase the "spectacle". Report any anomalies on the race route to the Commissioners or the Police. Do not litter the woods or the place around you. Do not light fires in the woods, you could cause fires.
